Sexual & Reproductive Health

80% of service delivery points provide integrated sexual reproductive health services including family planning

1.4M women reached with sexual reproductive health services by 2024

950,000 individuals received family planning information

700,000 additional users of modern contraceptives

Gender Equality & Women's Empowerment

Twelve state national institutions with gender-based violence mandate built their capacity to effectively prevent and respond to gender-based violence

250,000 individuals received quality gender-based violence services both in humanitarian and developmental settings

Adolescents & Youth

30,000 young people reached with life skills, civic education and prevention of violent extremism programmes

70% of health policies, strategies and protocols integrated adolescents' and youth sexual and reproductive health

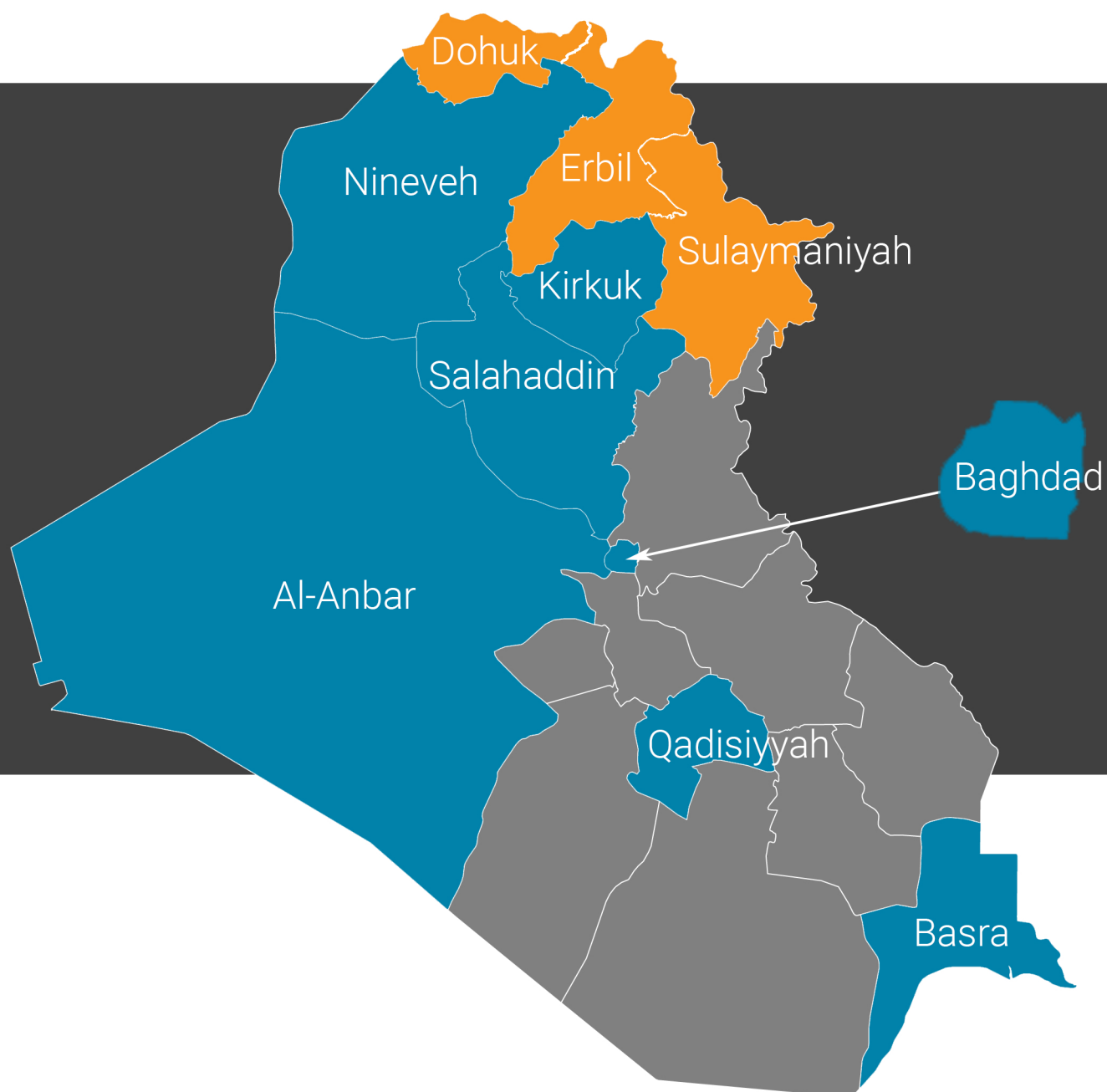
Population Dynamics
